## **About the CPD:**

No.4 Hospital Road is a Grade 2 historic building designated in 2010. Completed in 1921 and initially started as a scavenging coolies' quarters, the site has undergone multiple transformations over the past century, having served as living quarters for the Urban Services Department, school and government offices. In 2025, the Government allocated the site to GX Foundation through private treaty for its new Global Headquarters. While preserving the site's cultural significance, GX establishes the site as a base that combines office functions with community education. It will serve as a learning platform for the community and youth to engage with international medical humanitarian aid work.
